Voter Identification: Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification before receiving and casting a ballot. Voters who are changing precincts and those registering to vote on Election Day must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification, or prove residence, if required, may have the voter's identity and/or residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct or may cast a provisional ballot.

Voter Accessibility: Each polling place is accessible to persons with physical disabilities and has a ballot marking machine that allows a voter with blindness or visual impairment to vote privately. A voter may choose a person to assist them in voting except the voter's employer, employer's agent, an officer or agent of the voter's union, or a candidate on the ballot. Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in their vehicle.

Auditor's Office Hours: Absentee voting is available in the Auditors Office. Normal office hours are 8:00 am to 4:30 pm Monday-Friday. Absentee voting in the Auditor's Office ends at 5:00 pm on Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup>.


